Old Business:

- 1. Minutes from the March meeting were read and a motion made to approve those minutes unanimously carried.
- 2. Treasurer's Report: Total Deposits for March: \$1014.33 Expenses \$1377.59. Bank balance as of 3/31/2019: \$12,933.95. A motion made to approve the report unanimously carried.
- 3. Bobcat Rental: A bobcat (driven by Steve Brown) was rented from Able 2 Rent All on 3/13 and again on 3/22. We will be excavating/spreading mulch on one more date as weather and availability of volunteers permit.
- 4. Car/cart stickers have arrived and look great.

- 6. The Mellow Mushroom fundraiser on March 26th earned us \$75. The money will go toward toys, including a tub/pool for the small dog park, a couple of durable Frisbees and Chuck-its.
- 7. Mowing has been re-started.
- 8. No climbing on trees signs have been reposted.
- 9. Some boy scouts cleared the fence perimeter and vines, tree trimming and digging for \$180.

New Business:

- 1. Maureen will contact a volunteer to repair the wheelbarrow.
- 2. Susan Acosta was voted in to become a Director at Large.
- 3. Bark for Life: April 27th at Shakerag. We may participate in this too. Maureen will contact the sponsors. Mark can get us a tent to use for the day.
- 4. Handicap/Golf cart signs have been flipped back. Police approached a patron and threatened to ticket him for parking there while the signs were turned backward. We would like more non-handicap parking. We need to address this along with proper paving to make the park handicap accessible. The gravel road is treacherous to walk especially with an anxious, pulling dog.
- 5. We will order 2 banners for use at the bark events as well as for the parade to include name, logo, website and location.
- 6. We gave Steve Brown a money gift of \$100 and a card to say thank you for all his work.
- 7. For 4th of July Parade. We are considering renting/borrowing (Pinewood perhaps?) a trailer for a float. We'll also buy a larger amount of candy and dog treats this year.
