Old Business:

- 1. Minutes from the February meeting were read and a motion made to approve those minutes carried.
- 2. Treasurer's Report:

 - Total Deposits for February: \$1,291.19 Expenses \$20. Bank balance as of 2/24/2020: \$14,969. A motion made to approve the reports unanimously carried.

- 4. Mosquito control. A motion was made and seconded to have Kristofer get an estimate from his company.
- 5. Website: Still having problems with non-WordPress side of site. Anne will request that her tech people look into other options for us.
- 6. First Aid Kits: New containers have been purchased and Maureen is making sure the kits are loaded with fresh bandages.
- 7. Parking permits: Rita has created hang tags and Anne will get them laminated.

New Business:

- 1. A new slate of officers of the board of directors has been agreed upon and will be posted. This includes: President Anne Myers, Treasurer Maureen Kuebler, Secretary Rita Wilkinson, Director at Large Susan Acosta. Vice-President and another Director at Large remain open.

- 5. Tax forms have been filed.
- 6. Sponsorships: More realtors have expressed interest. We're still waiting to hear from Keller-Williams and SWBC.
- 7. We are making plans to add more mulch but must wait until the rain stops for awhile.
- 8. Robinson & Sons has been asked to continue their contract to mow the park.
- 9. We will look into the possibility of installing bat houses in the park to attract bats for mosquito abatement.
- 10. Gate checks will begin again soon as weather permits. It's too rainy now.
