Re-scheduled business meeting of November 15, 2021 A quorum was present and the meeting was called to order at 6:31 pm.

In attendance were President Anne Myers, Vice-President Bryant Goss, Secretary Rita Wilkinson, Director Susan Acosta (via phone,) Director Maureen Kuebler, Dan Aiken and Luis Gallindo.

Old Business:

- 1. October's meeting minutes were read and a motion made to approve those minutes carried.
- Treasurer's Report: Beginning Balance as of 10/01/2021: \$10,070.86. Total Deposits: \$2,433.64. Total Expenses: \$1,039.52. Ending Balance as of 10/30/2021: \$11,464.98
- 3. Banking Account: The new account set up at Delta CCU has been completed. We will work this month to transfer the new account numbers to Kroger, Amazon, Paypal and Square so we can close our Bank of America account. We will also create QR codes to post in the park to give easy access to our payment apps.
- 4. Canine Carnival: overall it was successful and well organized. Vendors and attendees alike were pleased with the turnout.
- 5. Repairs

a. Faucet on cement pad in rear park is leaking. Public Works will be contacted. b. Trees that need to be removed have been marked and a request was put in for their removal. We will contact Public Works again to see if they can be removed soon as an ice storm may bring them down and damage our fence.

 Cameras in park: We are looking more closely at motion activated wildlife cameras. We need to determine costs, placement, data storage, and signage, if needed.

New Business:

- 1. Improvement Project Ideas: Along with benches, swings or agility equipment we discussed creating one or two small hills or mounds for the dogs to run over and around (seen at another dog park.) These would probably be covered with synthetic grass. We will continue to explore the costs of these options.
- 2. Aggressive Dog signage. A definition we are considering: "a dog who is, in that moment, an imminent danger to a person or another animal."
- 3. Tree signs have been ordered. We also discussed a sign for "Chester's Gazebo" with lettering about 6" tall.
- 4. Christmas baskets will be purchased for Quinn and Public Works.
- 5. We will consider the costs of purchasing plastic bag dispensers and eco-friendly bags.
- 6. We will consider how and when to collect votes to adopt our new proposed bylaws.
