Business meeting of October 11, 2022. The meeting was called to order at 6:31 pm.

In attendance were President Bryant Goss, Vice President Anne Myers (via phone), Treasurer Marla Curley, Secretary Rita Wilkinson, Director Maureen Kuebler, Director Susan Acosta, Dan Aiken and Luis Galindo.

Old Business:

1. September's meeting minutes were read and approved.
2. Treasurer's Report: Beginning Balance as of 9/01/2022: \$7,798.63. Total Deposits: \$571.05. Total Expenses: \$611.97. Ending Balance as of 9/30/2022: \$7,757.89.
3. Improvement project: PTC Public Works will provide the dirt. We need to verify size (12'x12'x4'ish at about 2.5 tons per mound.) With Mega-Granite's gravel donation and Forever Lawn's turf/labor donation this should cost us nothing.
4. Repairs & Maintenance:
 - a. Volunteer Cleanup Day is scheduled for Saturday, October 22, 8-10am.
 - b. Maureen will purchase new brooms and shovels.
5. "Chester's Gazebo" sign is ready to be painted.
6. Howl-O-Ween event will no longer include vendors since many are unavailable. Sunday, October 23 from 2-4pm will be a costume party only. We are gathering treats and prizes. Contestants will be called individually and Luis will photograph participants. Bryant will ask our mayor and two others to be judges. T-shirts, sodas and water will be sold. We will purchase a new backdrop, pumpkins and hay bales.
7. Vendor/Fundraiser Festival: Tentatively called BarksGiving and planned for Sunday, November 13, from 1-4. We may collect pet food for local animal shelters, ask Piper from Healing 4 Heros to speak, ask a minister to do a blessing of the animals...
8. Social Media: meeting with James is to be scheduled, Bryant, Rita, Maureen and Luis plan to attend.
9. Incident Report: Anne will create a place to store them in the park.
10. Commemorative Signs: We will try to maintain the positions of signs already posted and contact previous purchasers about potential relocations or removal. Many of them are no longer involved in the park. We hope to be ready to start selling by December 1st. We considered creating a memory garden for signs and also offering commemorative bricks as well.

New Business:

1. Luis suggested we upgrade our entrance area to be more attractive and inviting. We will all look into more welcoming options as well as relocation of the directional signs leading to the park.
2. Air Show volunteers: we considered manning a booth but decided we cannot this year.
